Activity


Material

Procedure

- Print and cut the What's the Facts cutouts on the following page.
- Read off the game strips with the statement about the story and have the children answer whether it is true or false. Place or tape them to the correct side.
- Talk about how God blessed the widow in this story because she was willing to trust God and share with others.

Explanation: Remind the children that God wants us to share with others.
