

Dare to Be Daniel

Activity

It took great courage and faith in God for Daniel to break the law in order to be obedient to God. God was faithful to Daniel and protected him from the lions. Are you as courageous as Daniel? In this activity the children will learn some attributes Daniel had that helped him stay loyal to God.

Materials

Scissors

Procedure

- 1. Using the Dare to Be Daniel activity on the following page, cut out the lion parts.
- 2. Using a pen, poke a hole in each part of the lion where the metal brad goes.
- 3. Attach two parts of the lion with the metal brad.
- 4. Turn the lion's head to reveal the attributes of Daniel that helped him be loyal.
- 5. Talk to the children about what each of these attributes mean and how important these attributes are.

Explanation: Remind the children that God is with us in good and bad times.
