Key Concepts


- God is love.

ACTIVITY God Is My Valentine

God's love is so great that He made the ultimate sacrifice in order to save us. God proved His true love to us through salvation. In this activity, the children will see that our true Valentine is found in the word of God.

Bible Verse

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16)

Materials

- John 3:16 Valentine Heart template (Included)
- Red yarn
- Hole puncher

Directions

- Punch out the holes and have the children weave the yarn around the outside of the heart. Help where necessary.
- 2. Explain to the children that this time of year people talk a lot about love. God is the perfect example of what love is.

After the Activity

Remind the children that God's love for us is shown in His word.





ACTIVITY 2 "Love Is..." Mobile Craft

Love is a special word. It can be felt, seen and displayed. The many characteristics of love are the same characteristics of God. In this activity, the children will craft a reminder of what love is and see God's unfailing love for us.

Bible Verse

"Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not selfseeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil, but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres." (1 Corinthians 13:4-7)

Materials

- Colored paper
- Scissors
- Marker
- Yarn
- Tape

Directions

- 1. Cut one large and eight small heart shapes.
- 2. Write on the hearts as shown in the example.
- 3. Connect small hearts together using yarn on three separate strings.
- 4. Connect those strings to the larger heart.
- 5. Tie a string through the hole at the top of the craft.
- 6. Explain the different characteristics of love and what they mean.

After the Activity

Remind the children that God's love never fails.

ACTIVITY 3 Because He First Loved Us

We know love because God loved us first. When we know God, others can see His love shining through us. In this activity, the children will make a suncatcher to remind them that God shows us how to love.



Bible Verse

"We love because he first loved us." (1 John 4:19)

Materials

- Colored paper
- Tissue paper
- Transparent adhesive contact paper
- Yarn
- Hole Punch

Directions

- 1. Make a heart shape with no center.
- 2. Peel the backing off of the contact paper and lay the heart cutout on top of the contact paper adhesive side up.
- 3. Have the children decorate the contact paper with tissue paper.

4. Make a hole at the top of the heart and string the yarn through the hole at the

hole.

 Talk to the children about how God shows us His love.
 We can show other people God's love by following His actions.

After the Activity
Remind the children
that God shows us
how to love.



ACTIVITY Spreading God's Love

God's love is contagious. The love that comes from God should be shared with others. This is a fun activity that shows how God's love can be spread to others.

Bible Verse

"Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God." (1 John 4:7a)

Materials

- Paper towel
- Ball point pen
- Red marker
- Cup with a small amount of water

Directions

- Draw a heart towards the bottom of the paper towel. Explain to the children that without God our hearts are empty.
- 2. Fill in the heart with red marker. Explain that when we accept Jesus into our heart, He fills us.



- 3. Draw some hearts above the first heart. Explain that there are other hearts in the world in need of love. God wants us to share the love He gave us with other people.
- 4. Place the bottom of the paper towel in the water. Explain that the water is God and when we are in Him, we are able to spread His love.
- 5. As the water is absorbed, you should see the red marker shifting up to the other hearts, filling them. Talk about how we can share love with other people. Discuss some practical ways, but emphasize that it must be through saturation in God, not of our own strength.

After the Activity

Remind the children that we should spread God's love to everyone we meet.

ACTIVITY 5 Love in Action

God wants us to love through our actions, not just with words. There are many ways we can show love. In this activity, you will teach the children some ways they can put love into action. Talk to the children about how they can demonstrate to other people God's love.

Bible Verse

"Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth." (1 John 3:18)

Material


- "Acts of Love" list (see page 9)
- Colored paper
- Scissors
- Marker

Directions

- 1. Read the "Acts of Love" list aloud. Explain the different things the children can do to show other people God's love in their actions.
- 2. Do some of the actions listed with the children, so they can see how to make someone happy. You can also come up with your own acts of love.
- 3. Let the children write down the acts of love they have performed on the red hearts. Display the hearts in your house, like the refrigerator.
- 4. Try more acts of love throughout the week.

After the Activity

Remind the children that we can show other people who God is by demonstrating His love.



ACTS OF LOVE

- 1. Say something nice to someone
- 2. Share with others
- 3. Play with someone new
- 4. Say "Sorry", if you do something wrong
- 5. Smile at someone
- 6. Hold the door for someone
- 7. Make a care package
- 8. Give someone a flower
- 9. Say "Hi" to someone
- 10. Write a nice letter
- 11. Give a hug
- 12. Color a picture for someone
- 13. Make a handmade gift
- 14. Leave a "Thank you" note
- 15. Give a compliment
- 16. Say "I love you"



ACTIVITY 6 Binding Love

Love brings people together, even if they have differences. It does not mean that people will be perfect and never make a mistake. Love looks past the imperfections and mistakes to keep us in perfect unity. This activity demonstrates how love binds us together.

Bible Verse

"And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity." (Colossians 3:14)

Materials

- Colored card stock cut into strips
- Scissors
- Stapler

Directions

- 1. Using the paper strips, turn the open ends inward and staple to create the hearts.
- 2. Chain one onto the next and staple after connected.
- 3. Explain to the children how the different characteristics of love like forgiveness, patience and kindness can help bring us closer together. Talk about how love helps us to live in unity with one another and work together, despite our differences.

After the Activity

Remind the children that God's love binds everything together.



ACTIVITY God Is Love

If we know who God is, we will know what love is. God wants us to learn more and more about His amazing love. This activity will help the children explain their understanding of love.

Bible Verse

"God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them." (1 John 4:16b)

Material

"God Is Love" activity sheet (Included)

Directions


- 1. Have the children draw a picture of the people they love inside the heart using the "God Is Love" activity sheet. Ask the children what love means to them.
- 2. Have the children trace the important message of God's love at the bottom of the sheet.
- 3. Talk about some of the characteristics of God that show He is love (Like patience, forgiveness, mercifulness, etc). Explain that if we allow God to live in us, we will have these same loving characteristics of God.

After the Activity

Remind the children that God is love.
