Activity

The Israelites wanted a king so they could be like the other nations. It made God sad because up to that point he was their king, but he gave them what they asked. In this activity, the children will see what characteristics make a good king.

Material

Kleenex Box

Character Review Template

Scissors

Procedure

1. Print the Trust the Heart activity on the following page.
2. Cut out the character review strips and put in a Kleenex box.
2. Have the children take turns picking from the character strips.
3. Talk about the character trait and have the children decide whether it is a good or bad trait.
4. Tell the children that even though King Saul looked like he would be a king from the outside, he had some character traits that God was not happy with.

Explanation: Remind the children that God wants us to display a good character.
