

Tell the Story

Activity

The story of the Fiery Furnace is full of great lessons. Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego did not care that they disobeyed the king because obeying God was more important. They did not care that they were the only three who did not bow down to the statue because standing for God was more important. In this activity the children will see how well they can recall the events of the story and the lessons they learned.

Procedure

- 1. Print and cut out the Tell the Story activity cards.
- 2. Let each child take turns picking a card and making a sentence about the story. For example, if they pick the king Nebuchadnezzar card, the child might say, "King Nebuchadnezzar made a golden statue."
- 3. Talk about a lesson they can learn from that sentence. For example, God does not want us to worship any other gods or images.
- 4. Explain that even though everyone else did what he king asked, Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego did what was right in Gods eyes.

Explanation: Remind the children not to do wrong just because everyone else is doing it.
