

OSHUA AND THE BATTLE OF JERICHO

Sound the Trumpet

Activity

On the seventh day, the seventh time around the city, the priests sounded the trumpets and Joshua commanded the army to shout, for the Lord had given them the city. It wasn't' just the trumpets and the people's shouting that brought the walls down – it was the Israelites obedience to Gods instructions. In this activity, the children will make a craft that will remind them to listen to Gods directions.

Materials

Cardstock Paper Scissors Tape or glue Sound the Trumpet Template

Procedure

- 1. Print the "Sound the Trumpet" template on cardstock paper.
- 2. Have the children color and decorate the trumpet.
- 3. Make the trumpet shape by connecting both ends using tape or glue.
- 4. Have the children march around like God commanded the Israelites.
- 5. Let the children know that because the Israelites listened to God and they were able to do big things.

Explanation: Remind the children that we should listen to Gods instruction.
