



# THE ESCAPE FROM EGYPT

## Scrambled Plagues Game

### Activity

Ten times Moses asked Pharaoh to let God's people go and ten times Pharaoh said, "No!" Pharaoh hardened his heart to God and God had to send plagues to get his attention. In this activity the children will play a game that will help them remember the ten plagues God sent on Egypt.

### Materials

Paper Bag  
Bush Template Cutout  
Scissors  
Tape or Glue  
Candle

### Procedure

1. Cut out the plagues and put one in each egg.
2. Write 1-10 in the carton where the eggs rest.
3. Scramble the eggs in an empty container and have the children pick an egg, open it and set the egg in the corrects space in the carton. (To make it easier you can write the number on the back as they learn the order of the plagues).
4. Talk to the children about how Pharaoh hardened his heart to God and God sent the plagues so that he would let his people go.


**Explanation:** Remind the children that we should not harden our hearts to God.
